Welcome back to all of you for another year of learning and fun. We have been very busy over the summer working on a plan to make our school even better and to build on the successes of previous years. We will soon be able to share the headlines of this plan with you to keep you up to date with our focus for this year.

Our staff have worked hard to design another action packed curriculum which the children have already launched themselves into. There has been a real buzz around school and the children seem full of enthusiasm (as usual) and are really excited to be back.

Foundation Stage have been finding out about people who help us with their topic of 'Help.' Key Stage 1 are learning about 'Monsters and Magic' this half term and whilst doing some outdoor learning this week they discovered some huge eggs in the wildlife area. Their task now is to discover 'Who left them there?' Lower Key Stage 2 are finding out what life was like during World War 2 and they made some gas masks on their inspiration day. Upper Key Stage 2 are learning about 'Spies' so there is some Top Secret learning going on.

Hopefully you have met some of the new staff already and have had the opportunity to give them a warm Carlton welcome.
