

Carlton Primary Home-School Agreement

Parents and carers are a child's first educators. They are the adults who have taught their children how to walk, talk and dress themselves. At Carlton Primary School we believe that children will learn best if parents know, understand and are in agreement with the aims of the school. This agreement is to help the school and parents to work in partnership in order to support the children's learning. Please take a few moments to read and discuss this with your child before signing and returning it to school.

Parents/Carers will:

- Make sure their child arrives at school on time and properly equipped.
- Make sure their child is collected on time.
- Support their child with their weekly homelearning in line with the expectations of the Yr Group.
- Make sure their child's uniform is appropriate and follows the school guidelines.
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Support the school in developing mutual respect between children and adults.
- Attend parental consultations as well as other meetings about their child's progress.

Your Child will:

- Respect and follow the whole school rules and their classroom rules.
- Complete their homelearning to the best of their ability.
- Smartly wear the full school uniform.
- Have their PE kit in school from Monday to Friday.
- Speak politely to adults and children in school.
- Have respect for different cultures, religions and individual needs.
- Show respect for the school environment.
- Seek help from an adult if they are worried or unhappy.

The School will:

- Encourage your child to do their best at school.
- Provide a wide and varied curriculum to enable all children to achieve.
- Promote your child's self-confidence and develop an awareness of their individual strengths.
- Develop an awareness of Carlton's seven Key Learning Skills.
- Inform you of your child's progress at regular meetings.
- Provide a safe and happy learning environment.
- Send home regular homelearning.
- Keep parents informed about school activities through the school website and regular newsletters.

Together we will ensure that your child:

- Achieves to their best ability.
- Adheres to the school rules.
- Is respectful to everyone.
- Has any special need well catered for.
- Has respect for the school environment.
- Develops the skills required for the next stage of their learning.
